Who may enter artwork (Registration deadline is January 8, 2025):

- Artists and artisans of all ages including students are encouraged to enter artwork. Each artist may enter 1 or 2 pieces with the option to list for sale or display only.
- A new sub-category of artwork representing pollinators is being featured for this year's event.
- This includes those engaged in original creation or interpretation in the 2D or 3D visual arts such as painting, drawing, sculpture, installation/conceptual arts, fabric arts, photography, etc. or those engaged in the creation of original and distinctive one-of-a-kind articles with a utilitarian purpose such as jewelry, wearable art, pottery, metal fabrication, woodworking, and more. Entry requirements for Exhibition Days:

- Artwork must be inspired by and represent the natural or outdoor recreational assets of Clarion, Crawford, Erie, Lawrence, Mercer, Venango, Forest, or Warren Counties in Pennsylvania.
- All entries must be appropriately mounted or framed for display; include a holder for very fragile artworks.
- All artists must pay a \$10.00 registration fee to enter, or sign up for a 2-hour volunteer shift to help staff the event.
- All artists must complete a registration label and sign a Waiver of Liability for each piece of artwork entered.
- Due to limited display space, we will accept a maximum of 75 registered artists on a first come-first served basis.
- Submit a short bio, contact details, and a photo of each piece (.jpeg, 300 dpi) for the exhibition booklet.
- The public will vote for "People's Choice" awards in 2D, 3D, and the pollinator category. Votes received will determine the winners in the three categories.
- The Council on Greenways & Trails reserves the right not to allow a piece to be displayed.
- The exhibition event will be open to the public and pieces must be appropriate for all viewers.

Delivery and pick-up of artwork:

- Registered artists will deliver artwork to the event location (Thursday, February 6th from, 4:00 -7:00 p.m. or Friday, February 7th from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.), Barrow-Civic Theatre, 1223 Liberty Street, Franklin, PA 16323.
- Registered artists or their authorized alternates may pick up unsold items at the Barrow on Sunday afternoon, February 9th between 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. at the same location.

Sale of Artwork:

- Any queries about purchase of the artwork exhibited on event day will be directed to the artist. Pricing is the responsibility of the artist including required taxes, etc.
- Proceeds from the sale of exhibition pieces are forwarded by the end of February to the artists except that CGT will retain a 15% commission of each sale.
- One central "cash register" payment location will be provided on site by CGT and Penn Soil RC&D. Customers will be able to pay in cash, checks, PayPal, or via credit cards.
